I have received your request for an alternative irrigation schedule for private and community properties located within the bounds of the Waterwood Subdivision. I have reviewed the request along with pertinent information related to your Consumptive Use Permit 2-069-2778-3 issued by the St. Johns River Water Management District on June 20, 2002. As requested, and in accordance with Lake County Code of Ordinances, Article VII, Section 21-172, your request for variance to the standard irrigation schedule is approved.

The properties in Waterwood Community are authorized to conduct landscape irrigation in accordance with the alternative schedule provided here and illustrated on the attached map.
